

Yorkville-Bristol Sanitary District YBSD Wastewater Treatment

UNDERSTANDING YOUR BILL

Explanation of Charges:

The United City of Yorkville bills and collects the Yorkville-Bristol Sanitary District's (YBSD) "user charges" bi monthly (every two months). this fee is one of several services the people of the United City of Yorkville pay for.

To meet stricter standards mandated by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (IEPA) and to provide service to the area, the YBSD has borrowed \$9,000,000 (9 million dollars) from the State of Illinois Revolving Loan Program. Loan monies are paying for the expansion of the wastewater treatment plant located at 304 River Street. The YBSD also has borrowed \$1,088,039 from the IEPA in 2011 for the Utility Improvements completed. The dedicated source of revenue to pay these debts are part of the YBSD "user charge." The dedicated source of revenue format is a requirement of the IEPA to assure the low interest loan and the zero interest loan is paid back over the twenty year period.

The "YBSD" User Charges are as follows:

\$1.10 per 100 cubic feet of flow, providing that the user shall pay a minimum fee bi-monthly of \$76.11, of which \$25.45 shall be dedicated to the Debt Service for the repayment of the State of Illinois Environmental Protection Agency Act Loan.


